Children in foster care often face a whirlwind of chaos, change, and uncertainty. CASA Volunteers are a consistent presence in a child's life during their time in foster care. The Volunteer works to form trusting relationships with the children they serve and represent their best interest at all times.

What to expect from CASA:

- CASA is appointed by the Judge to fulfill the legal role of Guardian ad Litem for children & youth in foster care.
- Collaborate with attorneys, social workers, and other parties on the case.
- Interview parents, family members, teachers, medical professionals, therapists, foster parents, and other adults who may have information about the child.
- Make recommendations to the court about any issues or concerns about the child.
- Form trusting relationships with the child and represent their best interest at all times.
- The court order appointing CASA allows access to the child and all records regarding the child, including medical, therapeutic, and educational records.
