



ELDERLY OUTREACH PROGRAM

Assists low-income, 60 years & older with eyeglasses / eye exams, prescriptions, hearing aids, dentures and other dental services

KINSHIP NAVIGATOR PROGRAM

Provides resources, support, and referrals to family members raising family children that are not biologically theirs, for example, grandparents raising grandchildren, whether formal (court arranged) or informal (privately arranged)

LEGAL IMMIGRATION SERVICES

Department of Justice Accredited representatives provide consultation assistance with services such as naturalization/citizenship, permanent residence, family petitions, adjustment of status, along with many other services

DIRECT CLIENT ASSISTANCE

Offers emergency assistance to those in need (low income - under 60 years old) with rent, utilities, food, clothing, hygiene, eye exams & glasses, and prescription assistance thanks to funding from Lubbock Lions Club, LP&L, and generous individuals

FAMILY & YOUTH SERVICES (FAYS)

Offers assistance to youth (0-17) & families dealing with crisis or conflict at home or school, through short-term counseling, parent skills training, and offers a 24-Hour Crisis Hotline - **1-800-530-4704**

PARENT EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM

Provides support to single & low-income parents transitioning out of poverty through education by providing assistance to students currently enrolled in college, short-term courses, or job training, with tuition, textbooks, uniforms, childcare and other needs
